Immunizations Required by State Law Prior to Entering School.

DPT or DtaP (diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus), a minimum of four doses; polio, a minimum of three doses; MMR (measles, mumps and rubella), two doses; HBV (hepatitis B), three doses; and Varivax (chicken pox), one dose.
